1960s

1967

Robert Haas makes his first visit to Beaucastel and begins importing relationship with Jacques Perrin



1970s

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Robert Haas, Jean-Pierre Perrin and Francois Perrin visit California and start discussing a future project together



1980s

1987

Partnership created, with Perrin and Haas families as equal partners

1989

Property purchased in the hills west of Paso Robles. Beaucastel clones sent to USDA station in Geneva, NY

2000s

2009

First appearance of Tablas Creek (the 2006 Esprit de Beaucastel) in Wine Spectator's "Top 100" list

2003

Estate vineyard certified organic



1990s

1997

First estate vintage. Winery building constructed

1994

Planting of Beaucastel clones begins

1996

First of more than 5 million Tablas clones sold to other vineyards

2010s

2011

Purchase of 150-acre parcel adjacent to and south of Tablas Creek

2017

Estate vineyard certified Biodynamic



2020s

2020

Tablas Creek is first winery in the world to become Regenerative Organic Certified™



2012

Tablas Creek flock begins with the introduction of 20 Dorper ewes

2018

Muscardin, last of 14 Châteauneuf-du-Pape grapes, released from quarantine.
