

<p>93+ points</p>	<p>2019 ROUSSANNE “The 2019 Roussanne is energetic and aromatic, and with its unique exotic character, it offers some potential for added complexity with another 3-5 years of bottle age. It has dynamic aromas of musk and white pepper that segue to bass tones of beeswax, roasted almonds and mushrooms. The palate explodes with ripe fruits and pungent spices and then broadens out for a long, honeyed finish. 1,300 cases were produced.”</p>
<p>92 points</p>	<p>2019 ESPRIT DE TABLAS BLANC “The 2019 Esprit de Tablas Blanc is made primarily from Roussanne, blended with 20% Grenache Blanc, 14% Picpoul Blanc and 3% Picardin. It has a very pretty spiced apple perfume, with touches of musk and white flowers, honey and apricots. The palate is pleasantly lifted and tangy at this stage, hinting at broader, more savory tones to come with time in the bottle.”</p>
<p>91 points</p>	<p>2020 BOURBOULENC “The nose offers pure lemon-lime aromas with undertones of almonds, beeswax and yeasty orchard fruits. The palate is bright, fresh, pure and fragrant with bursts of citrusy character on the long finish.</p>
<p>91 points</p>	<p>2020 GRENACHE BLANC “The 2020 Grenache Blanc is scented of stone fruit and citrus peel, with nuances of beeswax and crushed almonds. The palate is tangy and refreshing, with bright citrusy and stony character and an uplifted finish.”</p>
<p>92 points</p>	<p>2020 MARSANNE “The 2020 Marsanne has pretty scents of grapefruit, citrus blossoms, white pepper and beeswax with a streak of stony character. The medium-bodied palate gains energy from its juxtaposition of broad, honeyed flavors and bright, citrusy uplift. It finishes long and textural.”</p>
<p>93-95 points</p>	<p>2020 ROUSSANNE “The 2020 Roussanne is exotic and spicy on the nose, offering pure, defined and layered scents of peaches and guava accented by lime peel, grapefruit, white pepper and musky floral perfume. The medium-bodied palate is plush, rounded and layered, with seamless lift and a very long finish. This was still in barrel when tasted and due to be bottled at the beginning of 2022.”</p>
<p>90 points</p>	<p>2020 VIOGNIER “The 2020 Viognier offers aromas of poached pears, citrus peel, white pepper and honeysuckle. The palate is light-bodied, zesty and citrusy, with leesy tones on the refreshing finish.”</p>
<p>93 points</p>	<p>2020 PATELIN DE TABLAS BLANC “The 2020 Patelin de Tablas Blanc is a very expressive blend of 40% Grenache Blanc, 21% Viognier, 19% Roussanne, 15% Marsanne and 5% Clairette Blanche. The nose features white apricot, honey and spring blossoms, with streaks of crushed stone and lime peel. The palate balances honeyed fruits and broad texture with tangy acidity and shimmering mineral character on the long finish. 2,290 cases were produced.”</p>

<p>92+ points</p>	<p>2020 CÔTES DE TABLAS BLANC “The 2020 Côtes de Tablas Blanc is a blend of 38% Viognier, 32% Grenache Blanc, 22% Marsanne and 8% Roussanne. Its bright fruit is accented by deeper tones of honeysuckle, beeswax, saline and roasted almonds, with top notes of grapefruit and spring blossoms. The palate offers intense citrus character and rounded acidity, finishing with gentle savory notes.”</p>
<p>94-96 points</p>	<p>2020 ESPRIT DE TABLAS BLANC “The 2020 Esprit de Tablas Blanc is a barrel sample of 46% Roussanne, 28% Grenache Blanc, 14% Picpoul, 5% Bourboulenc, 4% Clairette Blanche and 3% Picardin. Proprietor Jason Haas says this is the first time all six Châteauneuf-du-Pape varieties have been included in this blend. It has alluring aromas of lime peel, spring honey and crushed hazelnuts, a touch aromatically shy at this youthful stage. The palate is broad and satiny, expansive and perfumed, with juicy acidity and a very long finish.”</p>
<p>92 points</p>	<p>2019 PINOT NOIR FULL CIRCLE “Medium ruby, the 2019 Pinot Noir Full Circle is scented of plums and red berries with tones of autumn leaves, mushrooms and dried flowers. The palate is medium-bodied, silky and fresh with a long, earth-laced finish.”</p>
<p>92 points</p>	<p>2019 COUNOISE “Pale ruby-garnet, the 2019 Counoise has soft red berry aromas with tones of woodsmoke, dusty earth, Earl Grey tea leaves and citrus. The light-bodied palate has alluring, juicy wild-berry character and loads of delicate earth and spice accents, finishing long with a pleasant rusticity to the tannins.”</p>
<p>92 points</p>	<p>2019 GRENACHE “Medium ruby, the 2019 Grenache is autumnal and fragrant, with soft scents of strawberry, purple flowers, orange peel, tea leaves and spice. The palate is soft, bright and juicy, with perfumed berry fruit and a long, spicy finish.”</p>
<p>93 points</p>	<p>2019 MOURVÈDRE “Medium ruby, the 2019 Mourvèdre features red and blue berries on the nose with notes of fragrant earth, garrigue and citrus peel. The medium-bodied palate has grainy tannins, rounded acidity and lots of floral and citrus accents on the layered finish.”</p>
<p>93 points</p>	<p>2019 SYRAH “Medium ruby-purple, the 2019 Syrah has pretty scents of blueberries, lilac, mint leaves and dark earth. The medium-bodied palate offers intense, ripe fruits, gently rustic tannins and a long, fresh finish.”</p>
<p>91 points</p>	<p>2019 VACCARÈSE “The 2019 Vaccarèse represents the second harvest from these four-year-old grapevines. Proprietor Jason Haas says he believes it is the first varietal Vaccarèse to be bottled in the US. “We’ve never found this grape in existence outside of the Rhône,” he notes. “There are only about 13 acres in Châteauneuf-du-Pape and seven acres elsewhere in the Rhône. It’s used in tiny percentages in most places.” This varietal iteration has a medium garnet color and a gregarious perfume of cherry candy, red licorice, powdered sugar, orange peel and earthy accents. The palate is energetic and spicy, with clay-textured tannins and a unique saline character on the finish. “It’s reminiscent of Gamay from Beaujolais,” Haas says, “except for that grip.”</p>
<p>92 points</p>	<p>2019 PANOPLIE “The 2019 Panoplie is primarily Mourvèdre, blended with 22% Syrah and 16% Grenache. Medium ruby, it has a nose of black and red berry fruit with touches of iron, tobacco, citrus peel and dried flowers. The palate is supple and floral with uplifting freshness and a mineral-driven finish.”</p>

<p>92 points</p>	<p>2019 PATELIN DE TABLAS “The 2019 Patelin de Tablas is made up of 37% Syrah, 35% Grenache, 23% Mourvèdre and 5% Counoise. It has a pale ruby-purple color and scents of red and black berries, pepper, earth, charcuterie and bitters. The medium-bodied palate is soft and juicy with a balance of bright fruit, earth and spice, and it finishes uplifted.”</p>
<p>93 points</p>	<p>2019 CÔTES DE TABLAS “The 2019 Côtes de Tablas is a blend of 44% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 17% Counoise and 9% Mourvèdre. Pale ruby, it has fragrant aromas of raspberries, blackberries, tea leaves, earth and blood orange. The medium-bodied palate has juicy fruits and supple tannins, and it finishes with finely accented flavors.”</p>
<p>92 points</p>	<p>2019 EN GOBELET “A blend of 37% Grenache, 33% Mourvèdre, 20% Syrah, 8% Counoise and 2% Tannat, the 2019 En Gobelet has a pale ruby-purple color and scents of raspberry jam, orange peel, forest floor, violets and iron. The medium-bodied palate is supple and juicy with floral fruits and a long, mineral-driven finish.”</p>
<p>90 points</p>	<p>2019 LE COMPLICE “Primarily Syrah, the 2019 Le Complice is blended with 27% Grenache and 6% Terret Noir. Pale garnet in color, it has very earthy scents of plums, mushrooms, aniseed, dried leaves and tobacco. The palate is earthy and rustic, with spicy fruits and an uplifted finish.”</p>
<p>90 points</p>	<p>2019 ESPRIT DE TABLAS “A blend of 39% Mourvèdre, 30% Grenache, 21% Syrah and 10% Counoise, the 2019 Esprit de Tablas has a pale ruby color and aromas of wild red and black berries, citrus peel, dusty earth and dried flowers. The palate is earthy and gently rustic in texture, with a juicy, mushroom-laced finish.”</p>
<p>90 points</p>	<p>2019 TANNAT “Deep ruby-purple, the 2019 Tannat features lush black and blue fruits on the nose, with touches of purple flowers, iron and earth. The palate is fragrant and fresher than expected, with gently rustic tannins.”</p>
