### 2025 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Tablas The Bench’ Vermentino

93 points

“The 2025 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Tablas The Bench’ Vermentino comes from the Lodi area set on sandy soils. This offers white peach and pear notes alongside shades of kiwi and wet rock. The palate is fresh and lithe with a great sense of tension and loads of mouth-watering acidity. Drink 2026-2031”

### 2025 Tablas Creek Vermentino

92 points

“The outstanding 2025 Tablas Creek Vermentino comes from their estate vineyard and was stored in stainless steel before bottling. The palate is lithe and super fresh with a smooth mouthfeel and loads of kiwi and melon flavors. Drink 2026-2031”

### 2024 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty Blanc’ White Wine

93 points

“The outstanding 2024 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty Blanc’ White Wine comes from the Sierra Foothills. It combines 35% Marsanne and 35% Grenache Blanc with smaller parts Bourboulenc and Roussanne. Cashew nut and white peach combine with beeswax and notes of pink grapefruit blossom on the nose. The palate is lithe and fresh with a terrific texture and great sense of weight. Drink 2026-2034”

### 2024 Tablas Creek Roussanne

96 points

“A stunning wine from 2024. Walnut and shades of green papaya combine with banana and mango notes on the nose. This is dense and viscous wine that has incredible depth, finesse and length that just doesn’t stop. A knockout wine, with a killer

push/pull between weight and underlying finesse, enjoy now and over the next ten plus years. Only 260 cases made of this beauty. Drink 2026-2036”

**2024 Tablas Creek ‘Esprit de Tablas’ Blanc White Wine 96 points**

“The 2024 Tablas Creek ‘Esprit de Tablas’ Blanc White Wine is a stunning edition of this wine that combines 40% Roussanne with 25% Grenache Blanc, 17% Picpoul, with the remainder Bourboulenc, Picardin and Clairette Blanche. This is fleshy and delicious wine with serious tension, weight and underlying verve. Nutty nuances combine with rich melon fruits, with starfruit and mango accents, giving this an exotic edge. Complex, with serious weight and length, enjoy now and over the next fifteen years to come. Drink 2026-2041”

**2024 Tablas Creek ‘Panoplie Blanc’ White Wine 96 points**

“The 2024 Tablas Creek ‘Panoplie Blanc’ White Wine was sourced from top lots at the estate vineyard. This shows star jasmine and orange rind on the nose alongside shades of pineapple and honeydew melon, with nutty and stony nuances. The palate is seamless throughout the drinking experience, as this glides, showing heady melon fruits with sandalwood and stony nuances. This is a rich, opulent bottling that is up there with the finest white wines you will see in the region. Drink 2026-2041”

**2025 Tablas Creek ‘Patelin de Tablas’ Rosé 91 points**

“The 2025 Tablas Creek ‘Patelin de Tablas’ Rosé is mainly Grenache (71%). Nutty and earthy nuances combine with tart red fruits and pear notes on the nose. The palate is mineral-laden with the faintest kiss of sweetness. Don’t serve too cold to take in the outstanding texture. Over three thousand cases made of this delicious wine. Drink 2026-2031”

**2025 Tablas Creek ‘Dianthus’ Rosé 94 points**

“A stunning new Rosé, the 2025 ‘Dianthus’ is a world-class wine from mostly Mourvèdre and Grenache with smaller parts Counoise and Cinsault. Orange blossom combines with damp earth, red raspberry and shades of pink grapefruit blossom on the nose. The palate is dense and powerful with loads of mouth-watering tension. This is benchmark California Rosé. Drink 2026-2035”

**2024 Tablas Creek ‘Patelin de Tablas’ Red Wine 90 points**

“An awesome edition of this wine, the 2024 ‘Patelin de Tablas’ combines 49% Syrah with 28% Grenache and the remainder Mourvèdre and Counoise. Light to medium-bodied red fruits parade with orange peel, soy sauce and chalky soils on the palate. Drink 2026-2031”

**2024 Tablas Creek Counoise 93 points**

“The 2024 Tablas Creek Counoise comes from their estate vineyard. Translucent in the glass, this shows pretty red fruits and red rose petals with cloves on the nose. The palate is mineral-laden and very nervy with stony nuances. Drink 2026-2032”

**2024 Tablas Creek Cinsault 94 points**

“The 2024 Tablas Creek Cinsault is 100% varietal, offering exotic spices and red currants on the nose with orange peel and bergamot accents. The palate is spicy with bright red fruits alongside amazing chalky soil character. Very light on its feet, enjoy now and over the next six to eight years. Drink 2026-2032”

**2024 Tablas Creek Grenache 95 points**

“A knockout wine, the 100% varietal 2024 Tablas Creek Grenache shows pretty red rose petals alongside blood orange zest and cardamom. This is pretty, elegant and texturally beautiful wine that is drinking marvelously. Offering great nerve and chalky character, enjoy now and over the next eight to ten years. Drink 2026-2034”

**2024 Tablas Creek ‘Côtes de Tablas’ Red Wine 93 points**

“The 2024 ‘Côtes de Tablas’ combines 47% Grenache with smaller parts Syrah, Mourvèdre and Counoise. This is loaded with juicy red and dark fruits alongside orange peel, white pepper dusted bacon and plenty of mouth-watering acidity. Drink 2026-2033”

**2023 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty Rouge’ Red Wine 95 points**

“The outstanding 2023 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty Rouge’ Red Wine comes from El Dorado County. This is dense and delicious stuff with terrific tension and verve. Milk chocolate and smoked pork shoulder combine with orange

zest and shades of red licorice on the palate. Super complex and delicious, enjoy now and over the next ten plus years. Drink 2026-2036”

**2023 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Shake Ridge’ Syrah**

**95 points**

“The really good 2023 Tablas Creek ‘Lignée de Shake Ridge’ Syrah is 100% varietal. Tar, dark florals, dark chocolate shavings and tobacco leaf all combine on the nose. The minerality and richness provide a terrific push-pull here. Gorgeous, with tons of tension and a good sense of weight and mouthfeel, enjoy now and over the next ten years. Drink 2026-2036”

**2023 Tablas Creek ‘En Gobelet’ Red Wine**

**95 points**

“The 2023 ‘En Gobelet’ comes entirely from dry-farmed vines as this was first made in 2007. Mainly composed of Grenache and Mourvèdre, this smells of crushed wildflowers with beef brisket and fresh sage. The palate is mineral-laden and nervy with terrific stony and salty character. Drink 2026-2038”

**2023 Tablas Creek ‘Le Complice’ Red Wine**

**96 points**

“The 2023 ‘Le Complice’ is primarily Syrah (62%) with smaller parts Grenache and Terret Noir. This is dense and nervy stuff with an amazing chalky soil backbone. Plush red and dark fruits play well with Mandarin orange peel and shades of cloves, with Middle Eastern spices. Partial stem-included, this was also aged partially in concrete. Enjoy now and over the next ten plus years. Drink 2026-2040”

**2023 Tablas Creek ‘Panoplie’ Red Wine**

**97 points**

“The 2023 ‘Panoplie’ is a barrel selection, limited production bottling from Tablas Creek. Primarily Mourvèdre (61%) this is ultra-refined stuff with a scintillating texture and great underlying chalky character. Dense red and dark fruits parade with exotic spices and blood orange zest, iodine and white pepper dusted charcuterie on the palate. Drink 2026-2045”
