## REVIEWS

### 2019 Côtes de Tablas Blanc

**91 points**

“The 2019 Côtes de Tablas Blanc is a blend of 44% Viognier, 29% Marsanne, 19% Grenache Blanc and 8% Roussanne. It has aromas of white peaches, roasted almonds, lychee and touches of green herbs and flint. The palate is light-bodied and uplifted with leesy fruits, juicy acidity and an understated finish. It’s a little less flashy than its 2018 counterpart. 1,500 cases produced.”

### 2018 Côtes de Tablas Blanc

**92 points**

“A blend of 39% Viognier, 36% Grenache Blanc, 19% Marsanne and 6% Roussanne, the 2018 Côtes de Tablas Blanc offers bright touches of flint, flowers and roasted almonds with a core of peachy fruit. The palate is medium-bodied, silky and savory with bright freshness and a long, understated finish. 1,800 cases produced.”

### 2019 Grenache Blanc

**90 points**

“The 2019 Grenache Blanc has soft notions of honey and floral perfume on the nose with yeasty pear and peach fruit at the core. The palate is light-bodied, rounded and textural with gently nutty flavors, bright, fresh acidity and a long, understated finish. 900 cases produced.”

## 2018 Patelin de Tablas Blanc

92 points

“The 2018 Patelin de Tablas Blanc is a blend of 48% Grenache Blanc, 22% Viognier, 13% Roussanne, 12% Marsanne and 5% Clairette Blanche. It’s very much like a Chenin Blanc on the nose, with undertones of earth and bruised apples with pretty top notes of spice and dried chamomile. The medium-bodied palate offers savory fruits with bright acidity and leesy touches and a long, layered finish. 2,300 cases produced.”

## 2019 Picpoul Blanc

90 points

“The 2019 Picpoul Blanc has soft notions of marshmallow, honey and peaches on the nose and a light-bodied, uplifted and fresh palate with a gently textured finish. 280 cases produced.”

## 2018 Roussanne

90 points

“The 2018 Roussanne, aged in about 20% new French oak, has a nose of honeysuckle, lychee, white peaches and beeswax with flinty tones. The medium-bodied palate is texturally driven, with light savory character and an understated finish. 630 cases produced.”

## 2019 Vermentino

91 points

“The 2019 Vermentino offers soft pear, quince and white blossom aromas on the nose, with touches of honey and baker’s yeast. The palate is light-bodied, bright and lifted with nutty tones and a textured finish. 1,650 cases produced.”

## 2019 Viognier

92 points

“The nose of the 2019 Viognier opens with yellow peaches, lychee and musk with hints of green herbs. The palate is medium-bodied, silky and broad with perfumed fruits and great freshness to lift the long, pleasantly bitter finish. 500 cases produced.”

## 2019 Rosé Dianthus

91 points

“The 2019 Rosé Dianthus, made from 52% Mourvèdre, 33% Grenache and 15% Counoise, has a medium to deep cherry-pink color and soft aromas of peaches, strawberries, watermelon and berry candy notions. The medium-bodied palate is packed with juicy berry flavors and it finishes full of flavor. 900 cases produced.”

## 2018 Côtes de Tablas

92 points

“Pale to medium ruby-purple, the 2018 Côtes de Tablas is a blend of 45% Grenache, 33% Syrah, 12% Counoise and 10% Mourvèdre. The nose offers pretty blackberry and blueberry fruit with accents of bergamot, graphite, dust, coffee bean and citrus peel. The palate is medium to full-bodied and gently styled with a soft, juicy frame, perfumed fruits and a long finish. 2,140 cases produced.”

## 2018 Esprit de Tablas

93 points

“The 2018 Esprit de Tablas has a pale to medium ruby-purple color and a nose of stewed tea leaves, orange peel, boysenberries, fragrant forest floor and aniseed. It’s medium-bodied, soft, silky and juicy with perfumed fruits and a long finish.”

## 2017 Esprit de Tablas

94 points

“The 2017 Esprit de Tablas is a blend of 40% Mourvèdre, 35% Grenache, 20% Syrah and 5% Counoise. Pale to medium ruby, it has pretty aromas of tangerines, blueberries, tea leaves, tar and forest floor with loads of floral perfume. Medium-bodied, it’s concentrated and layered but delicately framed, and it finishes long with just enough freshness. 4,090 cases produced.”

## 2018 Grenache

91 points

“Pale to medium ruby, the 2018 Grenache opens with loads of bright raspberries, rhubarb, cranberries and citrus with notes of underbrush, dried leaves and spices. Medium-bodied, the palate is bright and lifted with a rustic tannic frame and long, spicy finish. 1,160 cases produced.”

## 2018 Le Complice

93 points

“The 2018 Le Complice is a blend of 60% Syrah, 25% Grenache and 15% Terret Noir. It has a medium ruby-purple color and very pretty scents of blackberries, blueberries, bergamot, forest floor and aniseed. The palate is medium to full-bodied, silky, perfumed and ultra juicy with a long, flavorful finish. 800 cases produced.”

# REVIEWS

## 2018 Mourvèdre

**91 points**

“Pale to medium ruby, the 2018 Mourvèdre is scented of tar and black and red currant fruit with touches of scorched citrus peel and potpourri. Light to medium-bodied and rustically styled, it offers perfumed, earthy fruits with a chewy frame and good freshness on the finish. 640 cases produced.”

## 2018 Panoplie

**94 points**

“Pale to medium ruby-purple in color, the 2018 Panoplie is incredibly fragrant with aromas of lilac, lavender, dusty earth, licorice and tangerine peel. The palate is medium to full-bodied with lovely layers of spices, flowers and earth supported by a firm, ripe structure and finishing long with great freshness and perfume.”

## 2017 Panoplie

**93 points**

“The 2017 Panoplie is a blend of 69% Mourvèdre, 17% Grenache and 14% Syrah. It has a pale to medium ruby-purple color and a nose of fresh blackberries, tar, Earl Grey tea leaves and tangerine peel with a bright hint of balsamic. The medium to full-bodied palate is very perfumed, concentrated and super fresh with a grainy frame and long, layered finish. 850 cases produced.”

## 2018 Patelin de Tablas

**91 points**

“Medium ruby-purple, the 2018 Patelin de Tablas is a blend of 40% Syrah, 33% Grenache, 21% Mourvèdre, 3% Counoise and 3% Terret Noir. It retains some rubbery aromas with notes of tar, soil and cassis. The medium to full-bodied palate has restrained flavors with a grainy frame, good freshness and an understated finish. 2,400 cases produced.”

## 2018 Tannat

**90 points**

“The rustically styled 2018 Tannat has a medium to deep ruby-purple color and scents of tar, loam, coffee beans, aniseed and blue and black berry fruits. The palate is medium to full-bodied with bright, earth-tinged flavors in a chewy but fresh frame, and it finishes long. 1,250 cases produced.”

## 2018 Vin de Paille Quintessence

**91 points**

“The 2018 Vin de Paille Quintessence is aged one year longer than the regular Vin de Paille, in 100% new oak. It has very spicy aromas of ginger, honey, oats, brown sugar and apple pie with a core of candied peaches. The palate is full and sweet—this has 104 grams per liter residual sugar—packed with spicy flavors and finishing long with just enough freshness. 50 cases were made.”
