REVIEWS

2024 Côtes de Tablas Blanc

93 points

“The 2024 Côtes de Tablas Blanc slowly evolves with a spicy blend of freshly split pine, dusty sage and ginger-spiked green apples. The palate is soothingly round with silken textures and ripe orchard fruits, while a tinge of saline minerality adds savory depth toward the close. A sensation of liquid stone resonates under sweet spice and inner florals as this finishes with excellent length and a salty flourish.”

2024 Patelin de Tablas Blanc

92 points

“The 2024 Patelin de Tablas Blanc punches well above its weight with a gorgeous bouquet of wildflowers, stone dust, lime zest and freshly sliced pears. The palate is seamless and soothing with a wave of minty herbs elevating ripe nectarine and apricot. Candied citrus tones meet a bump of juicy acidity on a lively finish with fantastic length. This is a total pleasure to taste.”

2024 Marsanne

92 points

“The 2024 Marsanne wafts up with a savory bouquet of ginger-tinged pear and enriching hints of almond paste. This is elegant in feel, weighty yet energetic as honied inner florals swirl above a core of ripe pit fruits. Long and beautifully balanced, the 2024 leaves the slightest nuance of Werther's Candies to fade slowly.”

2024 Grenache Blanc

93 points

“The wickedly fresh 2024 Grenache Blanc entices with dried herbs, white smoke and crushed nectarines. Near-oily textures sweep across the palate but are quickly contrasted by tart orchard fruits and citrus tones, leading to a sensation of total harmony. Acidity cleanses the senses as this finishes squeaky clean but impactful.”

2024 Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty Blanc

“The 2024 Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty Vineyard Blanc wafts up with a lovely floral perfume alongside exotic spices and freshly sliced pears. This shows its minerality up front, nearly salty at first before a wave of ripe, citrus-infused orchard fruits adds balance. Complex and lightly structured, the 2024 leaves a citrusy concentration and saline tinge as green apple

nuances pinch at the cheeks. The 2024 is a blend of 39% Marsanne, 35% Grenache Blanc, 13% Bourboulenc and 13% Roussanne raised in neutral foudre.”

2023 Panoplie

96 points

“The 2023 Panoplie is as dramatic and radiant today as it was the first time I tasted it. This dark beauty opens with a gorgeous bouquet of wilted violets and lavender, then reveals crushed rocks, incense, dried orange peels and exotic spice. It's deeply textural and silken in feel with a counterbalancing liquid floral concentration and a saturation of ripe red and black fruits. Residual acidity maintains freshness and energy despite a finely etched tannic structure. The dramatically long finish leaves a savory tinge of salted licorice and an air of rosy inner florals. This is beautiful today, but it's also built for the cellar.”

2023 Full Circle Pinot Noir

“An air of sweet smoke and lavender gives way to hints of ashen stone and dusty black cherries as the 2023 Pinot Noir Full Circle blossoms in the glass. Silken textures wash across the palate, supported by fresh acidity, as rosy inner florals swirl above a tart core of wild berry fruit. This leaves a raspberry concentration as it finishes long and gently tannic but not forbidding. I don't often think of Paso Robles for Pinot Noir, but the 2023 is quite a head-turner.”

2023 Syrah

92 points

“The distinctly savory 2023 Syrah tempts the imagination with notes of crushed violet, flowery underbrush, cedar spicebox and wet stone. It's lifted and feminine with crisp minerality and zesty acidity to complicate its tart wild berry fruits. This finishes long and structured with a cheek-puckering tension, as rosy inner florals linger on.”

2023 Mourvèdre

93 points

“The 2023 Mourvèdre wafts up with a rich blend of crushed raspberries, complementary ground cloves, minty herbs and a grounding hint of dusty earth. The palate is lively and spry with brisk acidity. Rose-tinged red berry fruits sweep across a crunchy mineral core, while perfumed violet and lavender tones linger. The 2023 tapers off with a pleasant tartness and excellent length.”

2023 Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty

93 points

“The 2023 Lignée de Tablas Fenaughty Vineyard Rouge blossoms in the glass with a pretty blend of sweet sage and dusty violet flowers that gives way to citrus-laced blackberries. It's silken and round with cooling acidity and vibrant red and blue fruits complicated by a sensation of liquid stone. The 2023 firms up beautifully through the finish, which is long and staining yet fresh with a resonance of wild strawberries.”

2023 Lignée de Tablas Shake Ridge Syrah

“The 2023 Syrah Lignée de Tablas Shake Ridge is a dark and savory beast. The nose mixes grilled herb and olive tones with ashen stones, animal musk and crushed blackberries. Surprisingly juicy on the palate yet still complex, it displays mineral-laden red and black fruits, complementary violet inner florals and a twang of citrus. This finishes potent and structured with edgy tannins and a lifting hint of rosemary.”
