## REVIEWS

### 2023 Esprit de Tablas Blanc

**95 points**

“The 2023 Esprit de Tablas Blanc is gorgeous, speaking in whispers yet with so much to say. It impresses with a finessed bouquet that combines nectarines and honied florals with ginger-tinged apples and pears. The palate is silken in feel with medium-bodied weight as a pure wave of ripe pit fruits and a subtle hint of spice takes on a citrusy twang toward the close. Tactile mineral tones add a crunchy sensation through the long, perfumed finish. A glorious Esprit de Tablas Blanc that is already a total pleasure to taste, yet with the balance for a lovely evolution in bottle.”

### 2023 Côtes de Tablas Blanc

**91 points**

“The 2023 Côtes de Tablas Blanc blends richness with precision, as notes of raw almond and white flowers complement a savory mix of crushed rocks, sage and crushed green apples. Lifted and juicy in style, it has a salty core of minerals and citrus. The 2023 finishes clean, leaving a crisp sensation of liquid stone and sour melon.”

### 2023 Roussanne

**92 points**

“The 2023 Roussanne has gained lovely depth over the past year, as dried apricots and ginger combine with a whiff of confectionary spice. Energetic and fresh, it shows a building richness that soothes the soul as an air of vanilla custard swirls and ripe pit fruit envelop the senses. A hint of sour citrus mingles with salty mineral tones as the 2023 tapers off with excellent length and a slight butterscotch resonance.”

### 2024 Vermentino

**92 points**

“The 2024 Vermentino bursts from the glass with a fruit-forward blend of lime zest, nectarine and mint cream. Decadently ripe orchard fruits and melon tones mix with a wave of fresh acidity and floral lift toward the close. Energetic and full of

personality, it leaves a saline tinge and a hint of sour citrus that keeps the mouth watering for more. Tablas Creek is a master of Paso Robles-styled Vermentino.”

#### **2024 Panoplie Blanc**

**(94-96) points**

“A rich blend of raw almonds, wild flowers, dried apricots and peaches wafts up from the 2024 Panoplie Blanc. Silky smooth and more savory than sweet, it offers ripe orchard fruits that cascade over a sensation of liquid stone as nuances of chamomile evolve toward the close. The 2024 finishes with outstanding length, leaving a hint of savory herbs and crisp mineral tones that linger. The Panoplie Blanc (name may change before release) is a new wine sourced from what Tablas Creek deems as their top 3% of white varieties from the season.”

#### **2024 Esprit de Tablas Blanc**

**(93-95) points**

“Perfumed florals and sweet melon tones introduce the 2024 Esprit de Tablas Blanc. The palate is soft textured and round, nearly oily in feel, with ripe apricot and peach offset by a tactile core of minerality. It tapers off with echoes of candied citrus and a salty sensation that keeps the mouth watering for more.”

#### **2024 Dianthus Rosé**

**92 points**

“A deep translucent ruby with orange hues, the 2024 Rosé Dianthus opens with a woodland-inspired blend of flowery underbrush, wet stone and wild berries. The palate is round and pliant, with a tactile mineral edge up front as ripe orchard fruits ride a stream of vibrant acidity. It finishes energetic yet potent, leaving a slight tart cranberry concentration that pinches at the cheeks. The Dianthus is packed full of character.”

#### **2024 Patelin de Tablas Rosé**

**91 points**

“The 2024 Rosé Patelin de Tablas is more savory than sweet. It wafts up with a dusty mix of dried flowers, crushed stone and freshly sliced nectarine. Lovely fruit sweetness emerges within, guided by fresh acidity as a twang of sour citrus pinches at the cheeks. A salty character develops through the finish, keeping the palate salivating as a hint of sour melon fades.”

#### **2022 Panoplie**

**94 points**

“The 2022 Panoplie is a radiant, dark beauty that slowly emerges with a whiff of incense and exotic spice, giving way to dried orange peels, sage and peppery wild berries. Deeply textural and nearly creamy in feel, it is somehow lifted by a liquid floral concentration and masses of ripe red and black fruits that saturate the palate. Brisk acidity maintains freshness and energy despite the 2022’s aggressive tannic edginess. The finish is dramatically long, leaving steely mineral tones and an air of rosy inner florals. The future is bright, but patience is required.”

#### **2023 Côtes de Tablas**

**93 points**

“Dusty and floral, the 2023 Cotes de Tablas wafts up with a delicate blend of violet pastille, incense and woodland berries. Playful and energetic, it splashes across the palate with a core of tart wild berry fruit and a hint of citrus enlivened by zesty acidity. The 2023 leaves the palate completely refreshed, with an air of lavender and tart blackberry concentration that curls the tongue. Mineral tension speaks through this beautiful blend of 66% Grenache, 18% Syrah, 8% Counoise and 8% Mourvèdre.”

#### **2023 Patelin de Tablas**

**92 points**

“A delicate blend of wet stones, violets and crushed blackberries introduces the 2023 Patelin de Tablas. Juicy and round, it sweeps across the palate with lavender-laced wild berry fruits and tactile mineral tones. Slightly grippy yet zesty and fresh, the 2023 leaves the palate salivating as nuances of tart cherry fade. This is lovely juice and an incredible value as well.”

#### **2023 Counoise**

**92 points**

“The 2023 Counoise is perfumed with a mix of rose petals, violets, wild berries and sweet spice. Soothingly round, it offers ripe blackberries offset by a tart cranberry tinge as pretty inner florals amass toward the close. Crisp and wonderfully fresh, the 2023 leaves a gentle mineral crunch and a nuance of licorice to linger. It is hard to stop at one glass, and at just 12.5% alcohol by volume (abv.), it would not hurt either.”

#### **2023 Grenache**

**93 points**

“The 2023 Grenache displays a lovely savoriness as dried strawberries mix with peppery herbs and dusty violet tones. A balanced inner sweetness and creamy feel are present, yet the wine remains lifted and spry as ripe blackberry fruits slowly saturate. Slightly chewy and gently tannic, it finishes with wonderful length and hints of licorice and spice. Frankly speaking, I would never peg this cool-toned and precise Grenache as a child of Paso Robles. Beautifully done.”



**2023 Panoplie****(94-96) points**

“The 2023 Panoplie is perfumed and expressive, with a cascade of purple and blue flowers giving way to crushed blackberries, nuances of stone dust and spice as it comes to life in the glass. Sweeping across the palate with a lifted and graceful feel, it is silken in form, with ripe wild berry fruits under an air of sweet lavender. The finish is long and structured, with fine tannins and a bump of residual acidity that maintains energy as a hint of blackberry and sweet spice slowly fades.”

**2023 En Gobelet****93 points**

“The 2023 En Gobelet entices with a burst of crushed raspberries and cedar spice, complicated by rosy florals and nuances of underbrush. Wonderfully fresh and crisp in style, it offers pretty red berry fruit underscored by crunchy mineral tones, while a wave of fresh acidity maintains fantastic balance. Edgy tannins resonate as the 2023 tapers off with tart cranberry concentration and a hint of spice.”

**2023 Le Complice****94 points**

“The 2023 Le Complice is impossible to ignore, offering a savory blend of wild herbs, stone dust, worn leather and dried black cherries. Cool-toned and racy in feel, it presents tactile mineral tones that enhance tart blackberry and a hint of sour citrus. The finish is incredibly long, with nuances of violet pastille lingering over a web of sweet tannins. While enjoyable already, this 2023 will reward patience.”
