Blended of 43% Viognier, 40% Grenache Blanc, 14% Marsanne and 3% Roussanne, the 2016 Cote de Tablas Blanc has an alluring nose of peach cobbler, marzipan and white pepper with a savory/mineral undercurrent of rising dough and crushed stones. Medium-bodied with great poise in the mouth, the palate is wonderfully minerally with a lively line delivering a long, refreshing finish. 1,750 cases were made.
