REVIEWS

2024 Esprit de Tablas Blanc

93 points

“Lemon blossom and lightly hued honey aromas decorate the nose of this always fascinating blend of 40% Roussanne, 26% Grenache Blanc, 17% Picpoul Blanc, 11% Bourboulenc, 3% Picardan and 3% Clairette Blanche. The palate is hefty in weight though fresh in flavor, offering layers of round stonefruit set against a rocky minerality. — Matt Kettmann”

2025 Vermentino (Editor's Choice)

93 points

“This grape, which exhibits brightness and depth in climates warm and cooler, could really be the future in many parts of California. This bottling offers white flower, wax and lime pith on the nose. The palate starts in a linear fashion with flavors of citrus pith, wet stone and melon rind, holding its tightness through the finish. — Matt Kettmann”

2025 Dianthus Rosé

91 points

“This is the richer, darker rosé that this brand releases every year, perfect to pair with heartier fare. The blend of 42% Mourvèdre, 40% Grenache, 13% Cunoise and 5% Cinsaut starts with clean aromas of cherry, strawberry and chalk dust on the nose. The palate is mostly about light cherry flavors and a grippy texture. — Matt Kettmann”

2025 Patelin de Tablas Rosé

92 points

“A yellowish hue of pink in the glass, this seven-vineyard rosé blend of 71% Grenache, 21% Mourvèdre, 5% Vermentin and 3% Cunoise offers wet stone, cantaloupe rind and orange blossom aromas on the nose. The palate is very grippy, framing chilled melon, Meyer lemon and orange peel flavors. — Matt Kettmann”

2024 Côtes de Tablas

94 points

“Bright pomegranate, raspberry, white pepper and thyme present a classic range of aromas on this blend of 47% Grenache, 28% Syrah, 13% Cunoise and 12% Mourvèdre. The palate picks up some black pepper elements atop the harmonious fruit and spice combination, and will only grow more elegant and intriguing with patience. Drink now-2044. — Matt Kettmann”

2024 Patelin de Tablas (Editor's Choice)

94 points

“A lighter color in the glass, this blend of 49% Syrah, 28% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre and 3% Cunoise, which comes from 12 vineyards, is a fantastic look at Paso Robles done delicately. The nose offers crisp aromas of red plum, pomegranate and light herb, while the palate is bright in plum, thyme, black pepper and fennel pollen flavors. Elegant yet easygoing, this is a nice wine for daytime or evening enjoyment. — Matt Kettmann”
