"Tablas Creek is the exciting joint venture between the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel in the Rhône and Robert Haas, their American importer. After five years searching for a suitable vineyard and Beaucastel rootstocks that took three years to clear quarantine, they have come up with a wine worth waiting for. Made from five Rhône grapes – but for the most part Marsanne, Viognier and Roussanne – it has broad, spicy flavours and a rich but dry finish."
