TABLAS CREEK VINEYARD BLANC 1999 PASO ROBLES



“Tablas Creek is the exciting joint venture between the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel in the Rhône and Robert Haas, their American importer. After five years searching for a suitable vineyard and Beaucastel rootstocks that took three years to clear quarantine, they have come up with a wine worth waiting for. Made from five Rhône grapes – but for the most part Marsanne, Viognier and Roussanne – it has broad, spicy flavours and a rich but dry finish.”
