- Tablas Creek's signature red wine is a traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietals:

50% Mourvèdre

27% Syrah

17% Grenache

6% Counoise

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

Features a rich briary nose of blackberry and rare steak, an elegant palate of ripe tannins, smoky flavors and peppered fruits, and a lingering finish of black cherry and spice.
