45% Grenache

22% Syrah

21% Mourvèdre

12% Counoise

- Vines imported from Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A bright fruit nose of cherries and raspberries laced with smoke and spice. Juicy and rich in the mouth, with ripe tannins and a long elegant nutmeg finish.
