- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- · Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A juicy, meaty nose of rare steak, pepper and blueberry. Juicy and rich in the mouth, with ripe tannins and a finish laced with licorice.
