- Grenache is the most widely planted grape in the Rhône Valley, producing wines notable for fruit, spice and acidity. Syrah adds a touch of firmness on the finish and slightly darker color.

90% Grenache 10% Syrah

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- · Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

Bright, juicy flavors of cherry, watermelon and plum, medium body, and a vibrant, spicy finish.
