CÔTES de TABLAS BLANC 2013

- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- A traditional blend of white Rhône varietals:
 - 39% Viognier*
 - 29% Grenache Blanc*
 - 20% Marsanne*
 - 12% Roussanne*
- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- Estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A blend reminiscent of Northern Rhône white wines, it features the lushly aromatic Viognier, whose richness is balanced by the structure and minerality of Marsanne and Roussanne, and the crisp acids of Grenache Blanc.
