- A traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietals:

38% Mourvèdre 34% Syrah

34% Syran

24% Grenache

4% Counoise

- Vines imported from Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.
- Copious aromas of cherries, roasted meats and spice. In the mouth, an elegant balance of ripe plum, loam, and licorice, backed by firm but ripe tannins.
