

RESERVE CUVÉE 1999

- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel in Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France.
- Vines of Tablas Creek Vineyard originated from Beaucastel.
- Grown on chalky clay soils of the same geologic origin as those in Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- Wines produced from grapes grown exclusively on our estate.
- Fermented using its native yeasts.
- A traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietal grapes:

40% Mourvèdre 27% Grenache Noir 23% Syrah 10% Counoise

- Reserve Cuvée 1999 is deeply colored, richly intense, highly extracted wine, redolent of ripe cherries, raspberries, currants and blueberries held together in a velvety tannic structure.
- Limited production of 2208 cases.
