- *Vines of Tablas Creek Vineyard originated from Beaucastel.*
- *Grown on chalky clay soils of the same geologic origin as those in Châteauneuf-du-Pape.*
- *Organically farmed vineyard.*
- *Wines produced from grapes grown exclusively on our estate.*
- *Fermented using its native yeasts.*
- *A traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietal grapes:*
 - 49% Mourvèdre*
 - 34% Grenache*
 - 17% Counoise*
- *This complex rosé has rich, well-developed flavors of red fruits on the palate and a long, smooth finish. A crisp and elegant rosé.*
- *Limited production of 140 cases.*
