- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands
- Syrah, native to the Northern Rhône, is the most widely planted Rhône varietal in California, and produces wines of dark color, powerful flavors of black fruit, butter and wood smoke.
- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A nose of pepper, black raspberry and wood smoke with intense ripe flavors of blackberry and spice, fine tannins and gentle oak, and a long, elegant finish.
