First Plate

"Lobster and Leek Bisque"

Creamy veloute of melted leeks and lobster meat in a garlic

vegetable broth

2018 Tablas Creek Vineyard Roussanne

Second Plate

"Foie Gras Salad"

Seared foie gras morsels, braised cherries, sauté of Swiss chard

and wild mushrooms

2004 Tablas Creek Vineyard Mourvedre

Third Plate

"Lamb Shoulder"

Blackberry-lacquered lamb shoulder stuffed with dried

cranberries and spinach

2010 Tablas Creek Vineyard Esprit de Beaucastel "Panoplie"

Fourth Plate

"Stuffed Peppers"

Roasted piquillo peppers stuffed with Cabrales and walnuts

Fifth Plate

"Pineapple Upside Down Cake"

Sour cream poundcake, pineapple chunks, orange creme fraiche

2019 Tablas Creek Vineyard Vermentino

Grape Variety: 100% Vermentino

Appearance: pale golden-green

On the nose: lemon leaf, limestone

On the palate: crisp, refreshing acidity, citrus, minerality

2018 Tablas Creek Vineyard Roussanne

Grape Variety: 100% Roussanne

Appearance: bright gold

On the nose: cedar, honey, orange peel, cardamom

On the palate: caramel, ripe pear, sweet oak, hazelnut

2004 Tablas Creek Vineyard Mourvedre

Grape Variety: 100% Mourvedre

Appearance: inky red

On the nose: cherry, fig, mocha, spice

On the palate: leathery, loamy

2010 Tablas Creek Vineyard Esprit de Beaucastel "Panoplie"

Grape Variety: 60% Mourvedre, 30% Grenache, 10% Syrah

Appearance: rich ruby red

On the nose: blueberries, plum, black olive

On the palate: licorice, saline, complex, balanced

2019 Tablas Creek Vineyard Esprit de Tablas

Grape Variety: 39% Mourvedre, 30% Grenache, 21% Syrah, 10% Counoise

Appearance: violet cherry red

On the nose: raspberry, leather, spice

On the palate: dark fruit, dried currant, cinnamon

2019 Tablas Creek Vineyard Petit Manseng

Grape Variety: 100% Petit Manseng

Appearance: medium gold

On the nose: honey, citrus leaf, grilled pineapple

On the palate: candied orange peel, herbaceous, lovely acidity
